



POLICY ON POTENTIAL CONFLICTS with SAT/AP EXAMS

MSSEF realizes that there may be conflicts with the scheduling of SAT and AP exams and MSSEF events. However, please note that science fair students have the option to schedule these exams without conflict.

- Plan in advance and schedule exams for dates that do not conflict with School, Regional or State Fairs.
- You can schedule the SAT exam for the Saturday morning of the Fair at a location close to the Fair. This allows participation in the Fair on Saturday afternoon. Science fair students may take the SAT exam in the nearby Somerville/Cambridge area. You can get information on how to register from your guidance counselor or online.
- There is an AP late testing period. You can get information on how to register from your AP coordinator or online.

Of note, the statewide High School Fair has been at MIT for over 65 years, and each year the dates are targeted to be approximately 1-2 weeks after April school vacation week. The dates that are finalized are dependent on several factors out of MSSEF's control, such as the dates set for the International Fair and six Regional Fairs in MA, and the availability of multiple spaces at MIT over a 3-day period.
