



Judges - Parking & Refreshments – Friday Statewide Science Fair for High School Students @ MIT

Parking is Limited:

Please note that there is limited parking in the vicinity of MIT. We encourage you to use public transportation or carpool. If you drive, you may be lucky and find a parking space on the street. If not, the Science Fair has made arrangements for parking at two garages.

Recommended Steps if You Need to Drive:

1. The Hyatt Regency Cambridge at 575 Memorial Drive has a limited number of spaces. The Hyatt is located just beyond the intersection of Memorial Drive and Vassar Street. 2. If the Hyatt is full or if you prefer to park near Kendall Square, please proceed to the Technology Square (Tech Square) Garage on Portland Street. From the Hyatt, drive east down Vassar Street, cross Mass Ave, and take a LEFT onto MAIN Street. Take your first RIGHT from Mass Ave. onto PORTLAND STREET; garage is on the right. Shuttle Service from Parking Garages:

Shuttle service to the fair will be provided from both the Hyatt Regency and Technology Square Garages on Friday on this schedule:

- * Two early runs at 8 am and at 8:20 am
- * Ongoing service from 9:45 am- 11am and 2-4:30 pm, and
- * One final run at 5:30 pm.

Complimentary Parking Passes – valid for Friday only:

When you register at Kresge Auditorium, you may obtain a parking pass valid for the Hyatt or Tech Square Garage. Upon exiting the garage, please provide your MSSEF parking pass and your parking ticket to the attendant. The attendant will collect this as payment for your parking fee.
