



Policy on Handouts and Advertisement during the Massachusetts State Science & Engineering Fair

Participants in the Massachusetts State Science & Engineering Fair (MSSEF) may only present judges with a copy of the official abstract that was submitted during the online registration process for the MSSEF and is printed in the official abstract book, if the participants so choose. **Student participants may not hand out items** that include, but are not limited to, flyers, pens, flash drives, pins, disks, CDs, business cards, brochures, etc. If students have these materials as part of their presentation, they must ensure that judges return all aforementioned material at the conclusion of the interview.

Students **cannot** include awards, medals, personal websites and social media addresses, emails, QR codes, the name of any industrial setting or educational institution where the project was completed, school name, postal addresses, or telephone numbers, on their board/visual display for the purpose of advertisement. This is for the safety and security of all participants.
