MSEF sends a Massachusetts delegation of top students to compete at the **International Science + Engineering Fair** each year




Students learn to:

These are the skills that are needed in today's workforce.




99% said the fair increased their understanding of how STEM research and work is conducted



98% said the fair increased their interest in STEM careers



30% of students were hesitant to conduct a Fair project. Not all students who participate at the State Fair started with confidence and comfort with the challenge



Of the 30% of students who were hesitant to participate, 99% indicated post-fair that they are now confident in their ability to conduct future projects
