Optional for Reverse Science Fair participants- Sit with students and discuss your work, academic journey, or what excites you about STEM. Prompts will be provided to spark conversation. Lunch provided.

**Project Showcase Feedback (1:00–2:30)** Optional for all grad and undergrad students- Stick around and give encouragement to students sharing early-stage project ideas, as well as see all the amazing work the next generation of STEM leaders are doing!
